

PULASKI SUPERINTENDENT FINALISTS ANNOUNCED

The Pulaski Community School District announced the finalists for the position of district superintendent. They are:

- Richard L. Appel, middle school principal and transportation director for Chilton School District, and
- Rebecca J. Kurzynske, interim superintendent and director of personnel for Pulaski Community School District.

To determine finalist candidates, both the board of education and a community-based superintendent search committee met with four qualified candidates and conducted one-on-one interviews. The board selected finalists based on those interviews and the feedback provided by the community committee.

"We are excited about the finalists chosen, each of whom would be well-qualified to lead the Pulaski Community School District. We look forward to conducting final interviews with the candidates," said school board president Robert Skalitzky.

The public can meet the candidates at Pulaski High School on Monday, February 15, starting at 4:00. Starting at 5pm, candidates will have the opportunity to address the community and answer questions that were submitted by the public in the district's superintendent search survey that was conducted in November.

Afterward, the board will meet privately with the candidates to conduct final interviews. The board plans to announce its hire by March 2.
