

PULASKI SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENT SEARCH PROGRESS AND COMMUNITY INPUT

The Pulaski Community School District Board of Education announced the progress of its search for a superintendent, including additional opportunities for community stakeholders to engage in the process. At its business meeting on January 27, the board selected five candidates to interview from the applications that were received.

In the first round of interviews, the board intends to establish a 12-member committee of district employees and district residents that will have the opportunity to interview first-round candidates and provide input to the board. Committee members may not be listed references for any of the selected candidates, must be available for the entire time period of 8:00am – 6:00pm on Saturday, February 6, and must agree to maintain the confidentiality of candidates' personal information.

Please provide your name, address, phone number, and affiliation with the district (employee or resident). Members will be randomly selected to serve on the committee from the names of employees and residents received.

Afterward, the board will select final superintendent candidate(s) for a second interview. On Monday, February 15, all members of the public will be invited to a Q&A session with those final candidate(s). Questions posed to the candidate(s) will be selected from the questions asked by the community in the board's superintendent search survey. After the public Q&A, the board will convene into closed session to conduct interviews with final candidate(s).

Further details and location information will be announced shortly. Details of the superintendent search process may be modified if circumstances necessitating change arise. The Board of Education expects to announce its final hire on March 2.
