Oconto Electric Cooperative is offering five, \$750 scholarships to graduating seniors who plan to continue their education beyond high school in an accredited college, or technical school. Any graduating high school senior whose parent or guardian is a RESIDENTIAL MEMBER OF OCONTO ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE IS ELIGIBLE. (Residential is defined as having the primary residence is within OEC's service territory.) Scholarship awards will be paid out upon entry into the second full-time semester of post high school education.

Scholarship winners will be selected by the Scholarship Committee at Oconto Electric based on open competition among all applicants. Competition will be judged on the following criteria:

- Grade point average and/or SAT/ACT scores.
- School, community and employment activities, awards and accomplishments.
- One-page essay on future school, life and career goals.
- One Third-party recommendation (letter of reference).
