### Criteria of Eligibility

Eligible applicants for this \$500.00 scholarship (*minimum*) are the **sons, daughters** or **grandchildren** of prior active duty service personnel who were on duty during the Vietnam era. The Vietnam era is defined as the time between January 1, 1959 and May 7, 1975. To verify the applicants eligibility, a copy of the parent's or grandparent's DD Form 214 (Certificate of Discharge) must accompany the application. If you applied last year, the DD Form 214 is on file and **not required** this year.

Applicants must be a resident of Brown County, WI. or a son, daughter or grandchild of a Chapter 224 member whose membership is current. A 10 point bonus will be added to the aggregate score of the applicant who is a child or grandchild of a current VVA Chapter 224 member.

The individual must have a grade point average of 2.5 (4.0 scale) or higher during his/her years of high school or college, and be enrolled as a full time student.

The award will be considered for renewal upon application by the applicant, providing that a verified 2.5 grade point average or equivalent is maintained. The scholarship renewals are available for a maximum of four years. Both undergraduate and graduate level students are eligible to apply.

Final selection will be made by the Scholarship Fund Committee of Chapter 224.

### How to apply

The following procedures must be used by all candidates. The application must be completed in full in order to be considered.

Candidates will be asked to complete an application, write a one page essay describing what the attached picture means to them, enclose the parent's or grandparent's DD Form 214 (if applicable) and return the application no later than **February 28, 2014** to:

The applicant then needs to have an official transcript of their grades mailed by their school to the above address. Applications and transcripts received after **February 28, 2014**, will not be considered.

Announcement of the scholarship recipients will be made in April for the school year beginning the fall semester.

### Selection Committee

The selection committee will annually review scholarship applications and determine the number of recipients of scholarships in any year. The committee is under no obligation to award scholarships in any year. Scholarship grants will be awarded solely in the order recommended by the judging committee.
