## History

Sunnyside was built in 1981 during a time when the PCSD was rapidly growing. The school is in Sobieski, near Little Suamico.

In 1998, the PCSD passed a referendum to build a new high school allowing the development of the Pulaski Community Middle School. Because of this, all district elementary schools, including Sunnyside, became a K-5 school in 1999.
