Valentine's Day will look different in our schools this year. Please follow the instructions below if you choose to have your child participate in the Valentine exchange.

- Valentine's exchanges will happen in classrooms on Friday, February 12, 2021.
- ALL Valentine exchange items must be brought to school by Monday, February 8th! We need to quarantine the items (isolate them in a plastic bin) before we can distribute them. You can send Valentine exchange items to school with your child any time prior and up through Monday, February 8th, but this will be the hard and fast deadline for bringing these items to school.
- Please send all of the items in a large Ziplock bag, or some other type of plastic bag, with your child's name written on it (this will double as their Valentine's Day collection box).
- If your child is participating in the exchange please send an exchange item for all students in your child's classroom/cohort. Students will only be able to exchange items within their classroom/cohort.
- Exchanges can include Valentine cards, small stickers and/or small, pre-produced and pre-packaged candy.
- We will not be allowing any large food items in the classrooms (baked goods, snacks for the class, etc). Please don't send these types of items to school.
- If you decide that you don't want your child to participate in Valentine's exchanges, please make your child's teacher aware of your request prior to February 11.
- All Valentine items will be sent home to be opened. You certainly can choose to quarantine those items in your own home (recommended amount of time is 3 days).
