- Principal's Update: A principal was unable to attend
  
- Financial Update - Becky Backes
  - **2019/2020 Summary**: Since we were unable to have Family Fun Night in Spring 2020, our ending balance was much lower than normal at \$6,949.85.
  - **2020/2021 Summary**: We ended the school year with a balance of \$7,149.06. We were able to raise a few funds last year to help cover the few expenses we had.
  - **Audit**: Has been moved to the October meeting since we need an administrator to sign off on it.
  
- Community Updates & Upcoming Events
  - **Fall Fundraiser**: We have already brought in \$2,120 in online profit in the Cherryland-sponsored fundraiser. With 8 days left, we're hopeful we'll reach our goal. Fundraiser pick up will tentatively be planned for Tuesday, Oct. 26th. Only the PTO board will have permission to be in the school.
  - **DQ Nights**: Dairy Queen has yet to decide if they will be giving a coupon to be used during a certain week or give a flat donation to Glenbrook. With their dining room closed, their drive-thru line being long on a regular night, and being short staffed, they don't see our regular DQ nights as a current possibility. They will get back to Hilary K. as soon as they make a decision.
  - **Artist in Residence**: Sandy Melroy, a silk painter, will be spending 2 weeks in the spring with students. The PTO was also going to host Randy Peterson but due to current district restrictions, he will not be able to work with the students this year.
  - **Conference Night Meals**: We believe meals will still need to be pre-packaged this year. Kurtis S./Tom K. will take care of one night of meals for the teachers and the PTO will take care of the other. **After speaking with Kurtis, it was decided that the PTO will purchase Cousin's subs.**
  - **Other Fundraisers?**: Kylie R. was approached by a representative who does a "School Store" fundraiser. While Sunnyside had success doing it, we do not think it's a right fit for us. We were looking into doing a Chicks 'n Dip fundraiser in spring 2020. They have a good kickback and will look into doing that for our spring fundraiser this year. The Marcus Theatres fundraiser has been successful in the past, but with the inconsistency of theatres being open, number of people allowed in, etc., we don't know if it would be a great fit this year. Hilary K. suggested selling Scrip cards prior to Christmas. She will look into setting that up and compiling a list of stores/amounts that could be on the order form. It was also brought up about if Glenbrook Apparel could possibly be a fundraiser, unless it's put on by the school themselves. There's a lot of interest in clothing and we haven't seen order forms for them in a long time. Mylinda A. suggested doing a Take & Bake Figaro's Pizza fundraiser on one of the conference nights. She will speak with

Figaro's to get some info about what the fundraiser might entail. **Kurtis said conferences will most likely be virtual again.**

- **Vice President Election:** We had two candidates for the VP position: Mylinda Allen and Angie Nowinsky. They both told us a little about themselves and the 8 attendees voted. Angie Nowinsky was elected.
- Open Floor: The PTO room has not been cleaned out in over a year. Kylie R. and Hilary K. will plan on going in one morning to go through it and disposing of any expired items. Hilary K. will also work on putting together a PTO packet to be sent home to families, including a list of dates/times of the meetings, a reminder to use AmazonSmile, and a reminder to upload receipts to the BoxTops for Education app.
