

Personality Styles



Builders like to use tools and machines to repair and install things. They are practical and good at using their hands.

Holland Code: REALISTIC



Thinkers like to research and solve complex problems. They are logical and curious, and invent theories they try to prove.

Holland Code: INVESTIGATIVE



Creators like to design, write, paint, and perform. They value intuition and imagination, and enjoy expressing their ideas.

Holland Code: ARTISTIC



Helpers like to care for, counsel, and teach people. They value cooperation and connection, and they are good listeners.

Holland Code: SOCIAL



Persuaders like to make decisions, motivate and lead people, and take risks. They are natural influencers and managers.

Holland Code: ENTERPRISING



Organizers like structure and order in their work. They are good at working with data, files, lists, and little details.

Holland Code: CONVENTIONAL
