ACADEMIC ACCOUNTABILITY

- STUDENTS WHO NEED SUPPORT COMPLETING PRACTICE WORK BECAUSE THEY CHOOSE NOT TO DO THE WORK WILL BE GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY DURING AN ASSIGNED TIME DURING THE SCHOOL DAY.
- TEACHERS WILL GIVE STUDENTS A FORM TO FILL OUT AND TAKE WITH THEM TO COMPLETE THEIR PRACTICE WORK. THIS FORM WILL BE EMAILED TO THEIR TEACHER AND PARENT/GUARDIAN THE DAY IT IS ASSIGNED.
- IT IS THE STUDENTS RESPONSIBILITY TO ARRIVE ON TIME AND TO UTILIZE THE TIME PRODUCTIVELY.

ATTENDANCE

- ATTENDANCE AT SCHOOL IS ESSENTIAL TO THE LEARNING AND GROWTH OF EACH STUDENT.

 ABSENCE FROM CLASSES IS TO BE AVOIDED EXCEPT IN THE CASE OF SERIOUS ILLNESS OR
 FAMILY EMERGENCY.
- ATTENDANCE IS TAKEN EACH BLOCK.
- If your student is unable to attend for reasons of illness, appointment, etc please call the attendance office at 920.822.6501.

BREAKFAST

- GRAB AND GO BREAKFAST OPTIONS WILL BE AVAILABLE BEFORE SCHOOL. STUDENTS ENTERING THE BUILDING WILL GO TO THE COMMONS TO GRAB BREAKFAST.
- STUDENTS CAN EAT BREAKFAST IN THE COMMONS OR IN THEIR 1ST BLOCK CLASS IF APPROPRIATE.

GROWTH OPPORTUNITY TIME (GO TIME)

■ GO TIME IS AN OPPORTUNITY FOR OUR STUDENTS TO RECEIVE TIER 2 SUPPORT, WHICH IS A PRE-TEACHING OR RE-TEACHING OR EXTENSION OF CONTENT POWER STANDARDS.

HOMEROOM

■ HOMEROOM IS ON WEDNESDAYS DURING THE GO-TIME BLOCK. STUDENTS MEET WITH THEIR HOMEROOM TEACHER ON A VARIETY OF TOPICS BUT MAINLY FOCUS ON THE RAIDER WAY LIFE SKILLS OF RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY, TEAMWORK AND PERSEVERANCE.

I.D. CARDS

- STUDENTS WILL RECEIVE AN I.D. CARD AROUND MID SEPTEMBER. IDS WILL BE USED TO SCAN FOR LUNCH, THE HUB CHECKOUT AND FOR ENTRANCE TO FRIDAY FUN NIGHTS.
- STUDENTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO LEAVE THEIR ID AT SCHOOL AT THE END OF THE DAY.
- REPLACEMENT I.D. CARDS CAN BE PURCHASED IN THE STUDENT CENTER.

INTERVENTION - TIER 3

- Special Education and Regular Education students will receive Tier 3
 Intervention services outside of the students ELA and Math blocks.
- YOU WILL BE CONTACTED VIA EMAIL IF YOUR CHILD IS ELIGIBLE FOR TIER 3 REGULAR EDUCATION INTERVENTION.
- INTERVENTION WILL BEGIN SEPTEMBER 12.

IPADS

- YOUR CHILD SHOULD BRING HIS/HER IPAD TO SCHOOL EACH DAY FULLY CHARGED. IPADS SHOULD COME HOME MOST EVENINGS. OTH GRADERS TIMELINE FOR BRINGING IPADS HOME WILL BE DELAYED UNTIL AFTER THE STUDENTS HAVE DEMONSTRATED PROFICIENCY WITH APPROPRIATE USE.
- CANVAS WILL CONTINUE TO BE USED FOR ALL COURSE COMMUNICATION, LEARNING ACTIVITIES, GRADES, ETC.

LUNCH

- LUNCH/RECESS WILL BE SPLIT INTO TWO GROUPS BY LUNCH COLOR WITH ONE GROUP EATING IN THE COMMONS AND THE OTHER OUTSIDE FOR RECESS.
- LUNCH TIMES WILL BE:
 - 6TH GRADE = 10:24-11:19 (10:51 SWITCH)
 - 7TH GRADE = 11:22-12:17 (11:49 SWITCH)
 - 8th Grade = 12:20-1:15 (12:47 Switch)
- MICROWAVES ARE AVAILABLE FOR WARMING FOOD ITEMS.
- Recess
 - Outside for nice weather and in the auditorium for inclement weather.

PICTURES

- COUNTRYSIDE PHOTOGRAPHERS TAKES SCHOOL PICTURES AT WALK IN REGISTRATION AND WILL ALSO BE AT THE MIDDLE SCHOOL ON SEPTEMBER 1ST.
- PARENTS WILL RECEIVE AN EMAIL ONCE PICTURES ARE READY TO VIEW. PICTURES CAN BE ORDERED DIRECTLY FROM COUNTRYSIDE PHOTOGRAPHERS AND WILL SHIP DIRECTLY TO YOUR HOME.

PROCEDURES TO CHECK STUDENTS IN AND OUT DURING THE SCHOOL DAY

- STUDENTS THAT ARRIVE LATE, LEAVE EARLY OR NEED TO LEAVE AND RETURN FOR AN APPOINTMENT WILL NEED TO GO THROUGH THE STUDENT CENTER.
- PARENTS WILL ENTER DOOR 1 AND BUZZ THE STUDENT CENTER OFFICE STAFF TO REQUEST THEIR STUDENT. PARENTS WILL THEN FILL OUT THE CHECK IN OR OUT FORM ON THE IPAD AND WAIT IN THE VESTIBULE FOR THE STUDENT.

RAIDER WAY LIFE SKILLS

- OUR FOUR RAIDER WAY LIFE SKILLS ARE RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY, TEAMWORK AND PERSEVERANCE.
- STUDENTS ARE TAUGHT THESE LIFE SKILLS AND EXPECTATIONS WE HAVE FOR CERTAIN AREAS SUCH AS AT LUNCH AND RECESS AT PCMS.
- STUDENTS ARE ALSO ASSESSED ON THESE LIFE SKILLS IN EACH CONTENT AREA USING THIS RUBRIC.

SAFETY PROCEDURES

- OUR #1 RESPONSIBILITY IS TO KEEP OUR STUDENTS AND STAFF SAFE. SAFETY PROCEDURES ARE REVIEWED WITH STUDENTS TO START THE SCHOOL YEAR IN THEIR HOMEROOMS. WE WILL CONTINUE TO MAKE ENHANCEMENTS TO PRIORITIZE SAFETY FOR EVERYONE.
- SAFETY DRILLS ARE PRACTICED THROUGHOUT THE SCHOOL YEAR WITH STUDENTS AND STAFF.

■ STUDENTS SHOULD CHECK WITH THEIR TEACHER IF AND WHEN THEY CAN HAVE SNACKS IN CLASS.

STUDENT DROP OFF AND PICK UP

- SCHOOL STARTS AT 7:30AM AND ENDS AT 2:55PM. STUDENTS CAN ARRIVE ON SCHOOL GROUNDS BEGINNING AT 7:20AM. PLEASE BE MINDFUL OF THIS TIMEFRAME WHEN DROPPING STUDENTS IN THE MORNING. **STUDENTS SHOULD NOT ENTER SCHOOL GROUNDS PRIOR TO THIS TIME.**
- STUDENTS SHOULD BE DROPPED OFF AND PICKED UP AT THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS
 - 6TH GRADE STUDENTS DOOR 1 (ARCHED DOORS)
 - 7th grade students Door 2 (Band Doors)
 - 8th grade students Door 3 (Pool Doors)
- Upon entering the building, students have the option to get breakfast, then students will stop at their locker and go immediately to their 1st Block class. There will be no loitering in the hallways.
