PCMS Grading Practices:

- Grades are determined using a collection of evidence, emphasizing the student's most recent and frequent level of performance.
- It is important to note that grade feedback of a 2 on new skills is appropriate. It would be of note to see an IE (Insufficient Evidence) or a 1 needs support on standard.
- Separate grades will be given for academic and non-academic skills (life skills).
 - Life Skills will be in 4 categories:
 - Teamwork
 - Respect
 - Responsibility
 - Perseverance
- Parents are encouraged to access course content, assignment completion and formative feedback in Canvas.
- Parents are encouraged to access grades quarterly using Skyward. A hardcopy report card will also go home quarterly.
