

## GUIDELINES FOR THE LARSEN COOPERATIVE COMPANY HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP

Larsen Cooperative will be offering graduating high school seniors and currently enrolled post high school education students a chance to apply for twenty **\$1,000 scholarships**. In order to qualify for these scholarships the applicants must meet the following criteria.

- 1) The parents, parent, guardian, or individual applicant must be a patron of Larsen Cooperative and have purchased at least \$2,000 worth of goods or services from Larsen Cooperative from January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013.
- 2) Applicants must be furthering their education by attending a two-year agricultural short course program, technical school, a two-year school, or a four-year college.
- 3) Applicants will be required to complete a scholarship application (and possibly an interview) provided by Larsen Cooperative. This information will be evaluated by a scholarship committee which will consist of board members and patrons of Larsen Cooperative.
- 4) Scholarships will be paid as follows:

Graduating high school seniors must complete their first year of education and provide the cooperative with proof that they compiled at least a "C" average in their course work. The scholarship will then be paid and must be used toward expenses incurred during their next year of post high school education.

For those applicants already attending post high school classes, they must have completed at least one year and maintained a "C" average, and their scholarship will be paid and must be used toward expenses incurred during their next year of post high school education.

Applicants are only eligible to receive one Larsen Cooperative scholarship.

- 5) The scholarship forms will be available at local high school guidance offices throughout Larsen Cooperative's trade territory, Larsen Cooperative's main office at 1104 Mulligan Drive in New London, by calling 920-982-1111 or 1-800-924-6677, email at [twenzel@larsen.coop](mailto:twenzel@larsen.coop), selected Larsen Cooperative locations, and on our web site, [www.Larsen.coop](http://www.Larsen.coop).
- 6) The completed scholarship application must be returned to Larsen Cooperative at P.O. Box 308 New London, Wisconsin 54961, or dropped off at the main office in New London, no **later than April 15, 2014**.
