## From the Director



Dear Summer School Families,

A mild winter makes us want summer right now. As our parents and grandparents reminded us, patience. We know Mother Nature will always get the last word.

We will have some big changes this year, but for some of our older students, it will not be new. With the construction that will be taking place, we will be moving to PHS and Lannoye. We have been at both of these schools in the past. For grades 1-12, the majority of the program will be at the High School this year. Early Childhood, 4K and 5K will be at Lannoye. Outlying schools will be bussed to PHS and 4K and 5K students will be shuttled to Lannoye.

As in the past, the heart of the summer school program will run from 8:00am-1:15pm. We will again have free breakfast and lunch for ALL kids age 18 and under at PHS. Lunch will not be provided at Lannoye. We will again offer an extended day that runs until $3: 00 \mathrm{pm}$ at Lannoye and $3: 30 \mathrm{pm}$ at PHS. Our $4 \mathrm{~K} \& 5 \mathrm{~K}$ will have the option to ride a shuttle back to PHS and connect with a bus back to their home site or be picked up at Lannoye.

We also have a special treat this year. Since school is ending early, we will be able to offer 2 swim classes for a term (June 3 - June 14). Hopefully this will allow more students an opportunity to receive lessons.

There will be communications sent home multiple times and multiple ways explaining the specifics of the day at each site.

## Registration \& Schedule Information

## Online Registration

Online Registration for summer school will be open beginning at $5: 00 \mathrm{pm}$ on Wednesday, April 10th and continue through Sunday, April 28th. Out-of-District families may register beginning April 15th. Any changes must be made online by April 28th. Please see page 8 for detailed Skyward Registration Instructions.

The PACE Office will be open from 5:00-7:00pm on April 10th to provide assistance to families who do not have online computer access or need help signing up for classes.

The Summer School Office will be open from 8:00am - 3:00pm M-F. We can also be reached by phone at 822-6053 or 822-6058 and email at summerschool@pulaskischools.org. We will be available to assist you with any questions you may have and will do our best to return phone calls and emails as quickly as possible.

## Late Registration Information

To register for Summer School after the April 28th deadline, please call the Summer School Office at 822-6053 or 822-6058 or email summerschool@pulaskischools.org. Please be aware that available classes will be very limited.

## Out-of-District Families

Out-of-District families may register for summer school classes beginning Monday, April 15th, at $12: 00 \mathrm{pm}$. If your student does not live in or attend school in the Pulaski Community School District they are considered Out-of-District. Please call the Summer School Office at 822-6053 or 822-6058 or email summerschool@pulaskischools.org at least one week prior to the start of summer school registration to enroll or reactivate your student prior to summer school registration.

## Confirmations \& Schedules

Your online registration is your confirmation. Summer school schedules will be sent home, by first class mail, at the beginning of June as confirmation of registration and payment. To ensure that your student receives a schedule, payment must be made in full by the May 25th payment deadline. Schedules will list classes for all three terms, teachers, classroom numbers and lunch period.

## Payment Information

The deadline for online registration is Sunday, April 28th. After this day, all schedules will be locked. If you decide that your student will not be attending a class they are registered for, please remove the class from their schedule before the registration deadline. Course fees will be applied to your student's Fee Management account in Skyward Family Access on Wednesday, May 8th. After this date, you will be responsible for payment of all fees associated with Summer School classes regardless of attendance. Fees will remain on student's Skyward accounts until they are paid. There is an additional $\$ 25$ per term fee for out-of-district students.

Payments will be accepted beginning Wednesday, May 8th until Saturday, May 25th. As in the past, payments can be made online (highly recommended) with a credit card or by e-check or with cash or check by mail or in person to the Summer School Office. Cash payments must be exact as we do not have the ability to make change. Please do not send cash or check payments until the payment period begins. Any payments received prior will not be processed until this time. Payments cannot be accepted over the phone. All payments must be received by Saturday, May 25th.

There will be a $\$ 35$ NSF charge on all returned checks.

## Financial Assistance

Financial assistance is available to those who qualify for free or reduced lunch. Please call the Summer School Office at 822-6053 or 822-6058 for more information. If a students requests Summer School financial assistance but does not attend the classes they are registered for, the fee waiver will not be applied to the students account. Fees will remain on the students account and must be paid in full.

## Printing a Fee Statement

If you would like to print a fee statement for your taxes, please use the following directions.

- Choose Fee Management from the options on the left.
- Locate the student you would like to print a fee statement for.
- Click View Payments next to the student name.

## Refund \& Cancellation Policy

To keep class costs affordable, refunds will only be issued if a class is canceled by the Summer School Director or because of a family/medical emergency.
All refund requests must be submitted, in writing, to the Summer School Office one week prior to the start of the term for which the request is being made. No refunds will be given for classes and camps once they have started. Refunds for Term 1 will be issued by June 30th, and refund checks for Term 2 and Term 3 will be issued by July 30th.

All classes are subject to cancellation by the Summer School Director. Any class that does not have sufficient enrollment may be canceled. If a class is canceled, alternate classes will be available.

## Open House

Free District Summer Feeding Program at PHS

The District Summer Feeding Program will again be offered at PHS during summer school. Free breakfast and lunch will be served throughout all three terms of summer school and available to any child 18 and under. Students can also bring their own cold lunch and snacks from home. Each student's lunch period will be determined based on their 3rd period class and grade level. The lunch period will be listed on the student's schedule next to their 3rd period class. You do not need to attend summer school classes to have free breakfast and lunch, it will be open to the public and served to any child 18 years and under.

## Busing \& Parent Drop Off/Pick Up at PHS

Transportation, via school bus, is available from June 17th to August 2nd for Summer School. Bus stop locations are listed in the box to the right. Because we do not have a bus supervisor at daycare locations, only students enrolled in before and/or after care at a daycare center will be allowed to ride the bus to and/or from that center.

Morning buses will pick students up at approximately 7:30am and afternoon buses will drop off at approximately $4: 00 \mathrm{pm}$. You may drop your student off no earlier than 10 minutes prior to the scheduled morning pick up time and please have them picked up no later than 10 minutes after the scheduled afternoon drop off time. Please register your student online for am and/or pm busing.

Final Bus schedules will be posted on our website the Friday before each term begins.

If your student will be riding the bus home in the afternoon, they must be signed up for Afternoon Smorgasbord.

The parent drop-off and pick-up location at PHS will be Door 9 on the Saputo Stadium side of the high school.

All students registered for Afternoon Smorgasbord must be signed up for PM transportation. Please register for a bus stop location, Parent Pick Up or Walk/Bike.


## Skyward Online Registration Instructions

Registration for District Students Begins Online on Wednesday, April 10, 2024 at 5:00pm. Registration for Out of District Students Begins on Monday, April 15, 2024 at 12:00noon. All classes have enrollment caps and are closed when full. Be prepared by registering early and have alternate choices.

1. On the Summer School webpage, click on Skyward Family Access.
2. Login with your Skyward user name and password. If you do not remember your user name and password, click on the link "Forgot your login or password" and follow the instructions.
3. If you are not a district resident or your child does not currently attend one of our schools, please call 822-6053 or 822-6058 to enroll your student.
4. Select Arena Scheduling from the left column. Then click on a specific Term from the drop down menu. Only classes for the term selected will be displayed.
5. Courses will be sorted by
 description. Only courses the student can sign up for will be displayed.
6. Click the add button in front of the course number to select the courses you would like to enroll in. Click remove button to remove a selected course from your student's schedule. Clicking on arrows at the bottom of the list will give you more course selections. The third column shows how many seats are available for the class. If it is full, an F is displayed and you will need to select a different class.
7. Students cannot have a gap in their schedule as no one will be available to supervise them. Examples: A student may ride the bus in, take classes during Period 1 and 2 and go home rather than stay all day OR a student may be dropped off by a parent at 12:00 (Period 3) and take one class, Afternoon Smorgasbord and ride the bus home BUT a student may not enroll in Period 1 and 3, leaving Period 2 open, or enroll in Period 1, 2 and Afternoon Smorgasbord but leaving Period 3 open.
8. Click on the View/Print tab to verify your student's schedule and print out a copy of the schedule for yourself.
9. This enrollment process must be repeated for each of your children.
10. Student schedules will be locked on Sunday, April 28th. Fees will be applied on Wednesday, May 8th and payments can be made at this time. All fees must be paid by Friday, May 25th through Skyward Family access in the Fee Management area. You will have the option of printing out the statement and sending it in with a check or paying online with a credit card.
